## Plattsburgh City School District Chapter 408 Staff Agreement

## Chapter 408 of the Laws of 2002 in relation to providing teachers and other service providers with a copy of a student's Individualized Education Program

Chapter 408 requires each public school and Charter School to ensure that each regular education teacher, special education teacher and related service provider, and other service providers who are responsible for the implementation of a student's individualized education program (IEP) be given access to or a copy of the student's IEP prior to the implementation of the student's special education program.

This information shall remain confidential and shall not be disclosed to any other person, in compliance with federal and state laws and regulations, including the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act.

A professional employee of the school district with knowledge of the student's disability and education program will inform each teacher, assistant and support staff person of his or her responsibility relating to the implementation of the individualized education program and the specific accommodations, modifications, and supports that must be provided for the student in accordance with the individualized education program.
