

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION

The Superintendent of Schools is the executive officer of the school system, and as such is accountable to the Board of Education for everything that happens in the Plattsburgh City School District.

The Superintendent may delegate the exercise of his/her powers and the discharge of his/her duties. However, such delegation shall not relieve the Superintendent of his/her responsibility for the actions taken by others.

The administration of the school system in all of its aspects shall be delegated to the Superintendent, who shall carry out his/her administrative functions in accord with the policies adopted by the Board. The execution of all decisions made by the Board concerning the internal operation of the school system shall be delegated to the Superintendent.

The Superintendent, as the chief executive officer of the school district and its educational system, shall be vested with full authority for the administrative management of the schools in accordance with the policies established by the Board and applicable statutory law and regulations.

### *Order of Precedence*

The Associate Superintendent will automatically serve as acting Superintendent during any absence of the Superintendent.
