Office Discipline Referral (ODR) Definitions

<u>Major Problem Behavior</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Abusive / inappropriate language / Profanity	Verbal messages that include <u>high-intensity</u> swearing, name calling or use of words in an appropriate way.
Alcohol	Student is in possession of or is using alcohol.
Bomb Threat / False Alarm	Student delivers a message of possible explosive material being on campus, near campus, and/or pending explosion.
Defiance/disrespect/insubordination/ Non-compliance	Adamant refusal to following directions; profane response to teacher.
Disruption	Behavior causing an interruption in a class or activity. Disruption includes <u>sustained</u> loud talk, yelling, or screaming; horseplay or roughhousing; and/or <u>sustained</u> out-of-seat behavior.
Dress Code Violation	Student wears clothing that does not fit within the dress code guidelines practiced by the school/district.
Fighting/Physical Aggression	Actions involving <u>serious</u> physical contact where injury may occur.
Forgery/Theft	Student is in possession of, having passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's property or has signed a person's name without that person's permission.
Harassment/Bullying	Student delivers disrespectful messages (verbal or gestural) to another person that includes <u>threats and intimidation</u> ; <u>obscene</u> gestures, pictures, or written notes. Disrespectful messages include negative comments based on race, religion, gender, age, and/or national origin; <u>sustained</u> or <u>intense</u> verbal attacked based on ethnic origin, disabilities or other personal matters.
Lying/Cheating	Student delivers message that is untrue and/or deliberately violates rules.
Drugs	Student is in possession of or is using illegal drugs/substances or imitations.
Property Damage	Student deliberately <u>impairs the usefulness</u> of property.
Vandalism/Property Damage	Student participates in an activity that results in <u>substantial destruction or disfigurement</u> of property.
Weapons	Student is in possession of knives or guns (real or look alike), or other objects readily capable of causing bodily harm.
Other	Problem behavior causing this referral is not listed above. Staff using this area will specify the problem behavior observed.
