Classroom Discipline Referral (CDR) Definitions

<u>Minor Problem Behavior</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Inappropriate Verbal Language	Student engages in <u>low-intensity</u> instance of inappropriate language (i.e. swearing; ethnic, racial, sexual comment).
Physical Contact/Aggression	Student engages in <u>non-serious</u> , but inappropriate physical contact (i.e. pushing, kicking, tripping).
Defiance/disrespect/insubordination/ Non-compliance	Student engages in <u>brief or low-intensity</u> failure to respond to adult requests. Student engages in disrespectful activity such as teasing & name-calling; gossiping & spreading rumors.
Disruption	Student engages in <u>low-intensity</u> , but inappropriate disruption (i.e. whispering, calling out during instruction; making noises or faces).
Dress Code Violation	Student wears clothing that is near, but not within, the dress code guidelines defined by the school/district.
Property Misuse	Student engages in <u>low-intensity</u> misuse of property (i.e. scribbling on desk; urinating on bathroom floor; writing in text book).
Other	Student engages in any other minor problem behaviors that do not fall within the above categories.
