#### New Scholarship/Gift to District

This check was presented to Mr. Hurlock by Durelle Price on behalf of her uncle's estate. Ronald Jennett graduated from Plattsburgh High School in 1948 and was the Valedictorian. The donated funds will be used to create a scholarship of \$1,000 to be given each year to a Plattsburgh High School senior who intends to study mathematics, has a GPA of 90 or above, and has shown good character. [Board approval is needed because this is a gift in excess of \$500 and because the funds will be used to create a new scholarship that will be managed by the Plattsburgh City School District.]
