**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING,
BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION
PLATTSBURGH CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, COUNTY OF CLINTON, NEW YORK**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing of the qualified voters of the Plattsburgh City School District, Clinton County, New York, will be held in the Duken School Building in said District on Wednesday, May 4, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. prevailing time, for the presentation of the budget document. Beginning on May 3, 2022 copies of the budget document and the Local Government Exemption Impact Report will be available upon request at the District Office (Duken School Building), 49 Broad Street, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weekdays.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that said vote and election will be held on Tuesday, May 17, 2022, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., prevailing time, in the Thomas E. Glasgow Elementary School (School Election District 3), Duken School Building (School Election District 2), and Momot Elementary School (School Election District 1), at which time the polls will be opened to vote by hand upon the following items:

1. To elect four (4) members of the Board of Education: three (3) to three (3) year terms each, commencing on July 1, 2022 and expiring on June 30, 2025 to succeed Mr. Clayton Morris, Mr. Derek Rosenbaum and Mr. Fred Wachtmeister, whose terms expire on June 30, 2022 and one (1) to a one-year term, commencing on May 18, 2022 or as soon thereafter as the individual may be sworn in, and expiring on June 30, 2023 to succeed Mr. Thomas Lacey, who resigned.
2. To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2022-2023 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.
3. To authorize the School District to (1)create a Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of financing the general improvements, construction, reconstruction, renovations or addition to various School District buildings and grounds grounds, including site work and the acquisition of original furnishings, equipment, machinery or apparatus required for the purpose for which such buildings are to be used; (2)fund said reserve to the ultimate amount of \$2,000,000; and (3)annually deposit into the Capital Reserve fund such portion of the General Fund and/or available unappropriated fund balance as determined by the Board of Education. The probable duration of the Capital Reserve Fund is 10 years.
4. To transact such other business as may properly come before the meeting pursuant to the Education Law of the State of New York.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the election and budget vote shall be by paper or by absentee ballot. The hours during which the polls shall be kept open shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00
