Announcement of Order for Board Candidates

Five petitions for nomination of candidate for member of the Plattsburgh City School District Board of Education has been received, by the District Clerk of the Plattsburgh City School District. There are four vacancies; three seats are for (3) year terms, commencing on July 1, 2022 and expiring on June 30, 2025 caused by the expiration of the terms of Mr. Clayton Morris, Mr. Derek Rosenbaum and Mr. Fred Wachtmeister, Jr. and one for a one-year term cause by the resignation from Mr. Thomas Lacey. Absentee Ballots will be made available in the Plattsburgh Office of the District Clerk. Any person who will be unable to vote in person due to illness or disability; because that person will be hospitalized, out of the county or city on business, studies or vacation; or in jail for any reason other than as the result of being convicted of a felony, is eligible. Completed absentee applications must be received by the District Clerk not later than 4 p.m. on May 10, 2022, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter. Completed applications received after 4 p.m. on May 10, 2022, will require the voter personally appear at the Office of the District Clerk to receive an absentee ballot. Completed absentee ballots must be received in the office of the District Clerk by 5 p.m., on Tuesday, May 17, 2022, in order that his/her vote may be canvassed.
